Each bucket will include tooth brush, tooth paste, brush or comb, wash cloth, soap, shampoo, hat, gloves, and new socks. In the men's buckets, we add a razor, shaving cream and deodorant. For women, we add deodorant and lotion. In youth and children's buckets, we add crayons or colored pencils, small age appropriate toy, drawing paper or notebook, game/puzzle and maybe a stuffed animal.

If you would like to assist with the Christmas Buckets, bring monetary or physical gifts to Faith Church by December 8.
